

38. The Andhra Pradesh Technical Education Subordinate Service Rules

[G.O.Ms.No. 1113, G.A. (Rules), Dt. 7-9-1961]

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, and of all the other powers hereunto enabling, the Governor of Andhra Pradesh hereby makes the following Special Rules for the Andhra Pradesh Technical Education Subordinate Service.

2. The Rules hereby made shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st November, 1956.

Rule 2. (ii) Notwithstanding anything contained in this rule, the Government may for special reasons, authorise the filling up of any post in the service by transfer from the Andhra Pradesh Engineering Subordinate Service or the Andhra Pradesh Highways Engineering Subordinate Service, on tenure basis for a period of two years, which may be extended by further period as the Government may consider necessary.

Rule 3. Rule of special representation :—The rule relating to special representation in appointments (Rule 22 of the Andhra State and Subordinate Services Rules) shall apply separately for each of the categories mentioned below in respect of direct recruitment.

[Rule 3-A. Rule of special representation in respect of physically handicapped persons :—Rule 22 in Part II of the Andhra Pradesh State and Subordinate Services Rules in so far as it relates to the reservation of vacancies for the physically handicapped persons shall apply on and from the 13th March, 1981 only to Category 1 of Class I, Categories 2 and 3 of Class II and Category 5 of Class III in this service in respect of orthopaedically handicapped persons when they are appointed by direct recruitment :

Provided that in respect of physically handicapped persons, a person who has got slight Orthopaedically handicap in a leg or in the hand and who is able to do teaching and practical work without any hindrance shall be considered against the vacancy reserved for the physically handicapped]. (Added by G.O.Ms.No. 881, L. & E. (T.E.), Dt. 22-10-1981)

Rule 4. Qualification as to the age :—No person shall be eligible for appointment by direct recruitment to any of the posts specified in column (1) of the table below, if he has completed the age specified in the corresponding entry in column (2) thereof.

Explanation :—The age limits prescribed in this rule shall be computed as on 1st July of the year in which the selection is made.

Rule 5. Other qualifications :—(a) No person shall be eligible for appointment to the service in any class, category and post specified in column (1) of the Annexure to these rules by method of recruitment unless he possesses the qualifications prescribed in the corresponding entry in column (2) thereof provided that where the posts are filled in by deputation of officers from other Departments the qualifications prescribed in the Annexure shall not apply :

Provided that a person already appointed regularly prior to issue of these amendments shall be eligible for appointment either by promotion or by transfer as Assistant Lecturer in Polytechnics, Instructor in Polytechnics, if he is in possession of Diploma of the State Board in the appropriate subject with practical experience in a reputed concern for not less than 3 years after obtaining diploma. In respect of the holders of the compressed diploma in Civil Engineering, Electrical Engineering and Mechanical Engineering (D.C.E. ; D.F.E. and D.M.F.) practical experience for two years shall be adequate for the purpose ;

Provided further that the service rendered in the posts of Demonstrators in Polytechnics included in Category 3 of Class II or in posts of Workshop Instructors in Polytechnics shall count as practical experience for purposes of promotion or transfer to the posts of Assistant Lecturers in Polytechnic Instructors in Polytechnics.

(b) No person shall be eligible for re-appointment to a post in the service from another post carrying the same scale of pay, unless he possess all the qualifications prescribed for the post.

(c) Where any degree or diploma of a University in the State prescribed as a qualification for any post in the service, a person who holds an equivalent degree or diploma of any University in India shall be deemed to possess the said qualification in the subject or language in respect of which recruitment is necessary.

Rule 6. Probation :—(a) Every person appointed by direct recruitment to a category in a class of the service shall, from the date of which he joins duty be on probation for a total period of two years on duty within a continuous period of three years.

(b) Every person appointed to a category in a class of the service by promotion or transfer shall, from the date of which he joins duty be on probation for a period of one year on duty within a continuous period of two years :

(Amended by G.O. Ms. No. 23239, Edn., Dt. 21-7-1962 w.e.f. 1-2-1962)

Provided that :

(i) a member of the service when transferred from a post in one class or category to a post in another class or category in the service carrying the same scale of pay shall not be required to undergo fresh probation in the class or category to which he is so transferred, if he has completed his probation in the class or category from which he is transferred ;

(ii) he shall undergo probation in the class or category to which he is transferred, if he has not completed his probation in the class or category from which he is transferred;

(iii) he shall be entitled to count towards his probation in both the classes or categories aforesaid the period of his service in either class or category.

Explanation :—For the purposes of this proviso, a probationer reverted from a class or category for want of a vacancy and subsequently appointed to another class or category carrying the same scale of pay shall be deemed to have been transferred from the former to the latter class or category.

Note :—All the personnel of Industrial Training Institutions/Industrial Training Centres, etc., with quasi permanent status under the Government of India absorbed in the Andhra Pradesh Technical Education Subordinate Service effect from 1-11-1956 consequent on the transfer of the Institutes from Central Government to the State Government, who have put in a period of service equal to the period of probation prescribed for the respective posts in the Special Rules for the said service shall be exempted from undergoing the probation.

Rule 7. Promotion :—All promotions shall be made on grounds of merit and ability, seniority being considered only when merit and ability are approximately equal.

Rule 8. Tests :—(a) A person who is appointed to a post in Category 2 of Class VI, shall within the period of probation pass the Accounts Test for Subordinate Officers, Part I, unless he has already passed the said Test before he is appointed to the post.

(b) A probationer who fails to pass within the prescribed period of probation, the Test prescribed in sub-rule (a) but is otherwise considered suitable shall pass the Test within a further period not exceeding two years to be prescribed by the appointing authority. He shall not be deemed to have completed his probation satisfactorily and shall not be entitled to appointment as a full member of the Service nor shall he be eligible for any increment in the time scale pay applicable to him until he passes the said test, but such ineligibility to draw increments shall not operate to postpone future increments after he has passed the test. If he fails to pass the test within the further period allowed, the appointing authority shall forthwith by order terminate his probation and discharge him from the service.

(c) A person shall be exempted from passing the tests mentioned in sub-rule (a), if he has attained the age of 50 years before the date of his appointment to any post mentioned in these sub-rules.

Rule 9. Discharge, reappointment and appointment as full members :—For the purposes of discharge of probationer and approved probationers for want of vacancies, their re-appointment and appointment as full members, every post or group of posts in the category for which separate qualifications are prescribed shall be deemed to be a separate category.

Rule 10. Transfers and postings :—The Director of Technical Education shall be the competent authority to order postings and transfers of all members of the services.

Rule 11. Appointing Authority :—The appointing authority for the classes and categories of posts specified in column (1) of the table below shall be the authority specified in column (2) thereof.
